Students will be able to try the techniques as our classroom will be set up for you to experience hands on what you watched live from BERNINA. **Janine Babich will be our shop host when she presents ideas for each session along with her beautiful samples** If enough students request a virtual program to become a hands on class your \$15.00 fee will be deducted from the future class.
