**This can be a one-day or two-day workshop—it is your choice.** (We strongly suggest Software owners for both days)

Join one of the latest trends in quilting with Sylvain Bergeron and learn how to create a quilt design out of machine embroidery. In this class which is day one you will learn how to digitize a simple geometric embroidery motif and how to incorporate it in a quilt layout in the Bernina Quilter software. This is a unique experience for anybody with Bernina software or for anyone thinking about upgrading the editor software that came with your Bernina. Digitizing is the latest craze in quilting and embroidery.
